

## College Station Band Booster Meeting Minutes

April 13, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 7:01 pm by David Adcock, Band Booster Vice-President. Present were 5 Executive Board Members, 4 Band Directors and approximately 40 Booster Members.

### **Old Business:**

W.C. Doyle made a motion to approve the March 9, 2010 minutes. Jenny Lamont seconded the motion and the minutes were approved.

W.C. Doyle presented the financial report. A motion was made by Missy Meadows to approve the financial report. David Meadows seconded the motion and the report was approved.

### **Announcements:**

Jennifer Opiela-Miksch announced tickets will go on sale soon for the Band Banquet which will be held May 22, 2010 in the Archery Room at the A&M Rec Center. Students who have paid their assessment fee will get their tickets first, then tickets will be offered for sale. The tickets for non-band members are \$20 each and students may use their student accounts to purchase tickets. This Saturday from 9am-5pm, a group will be working on decorations for the banquet.

Mr. Adcock explained that Senior Scholarship Applications have been received and are being "processed." Scholarship checks are mailed to colleges in September. We had 16 turned in. Also, Seniors can "will" the money in their account until May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2010 to a sibling entering high school, or who is in high school. They may also "will" the money in their account to the Booster College Scholarship Fund. To "will" their money, they should fill out a transfer form and put it in the red mailbox in the band hall. If seniors do not turn in a transfer form before May 14<sup>th</sup>, the money in their account will go into the Booster General Fund.

Mr. Dixon discussed WTAMU Band Camp information. He said that 108 students went to band camp last year. This year camp begins July 11<sup>th</sup> and goes for 2 weeks. The cost is \$680. The transportation to and from the camp in Amarillo, TX is free. Several band directors will attend the camp. A Butterbraid fundraiser begins tonight to help with camp costs. Each Butterbraid costs \$11 with \$4.50 going to the student. Scholarships will be available to help with the cost. Fundraising is necessary to qualify for a scholarship. The band directors at the middle schools are offering scholarships to their students. The Boosters will be offering \$100 scholarships to high school students (entering 9-12 grades). Applications are available on the band website and due May 14<sup>th</sup>.

Jennifer encouraged members to check the band website, [csbands.com](http://csbands.com) to find out summer practice schedules and football schedules. These schedules are posted under the "Events" tab.

W.C. Doyle announced the golf tournament will be held April 24<sup>th</sup> and there are 2 open slots for individual players. If any would like to join, contact W.C. Doyle for more information or check [csbands.com](http://csbands.com).
